CIRCULAR

The National Voters' Day (NVD) is celebrated every year to mark the foundation day of the Election Commission of India, which was established on 25th January, 1950. The objective of celebrating NVD is to increase enrolment of voters, especially young voters, and also spread awareness among voters regarding effective participation in the electoral process. The theme for the 8th NVD, to be celebrated on 25th January 2018 is 'ACCESSIBLE ELECTIONS'.

2. In view of NVD celebration, a gamut of activities is proposed by the Election Commission of India. Therefore, it is requested to organize District-level and State-level Essay Writing, Poster Making, and Collage Making competitions. The above mentioned competitions may be conducted under the aegis of Electoral Literacy Clubs in each participant school, college and/or learning centre.

Subjects for Essays, Posters, and Collages

3. The subjects for the competition would be:

Institutional Coverage

4. The students from the following three different category groups would be covered:

Category I) Secondary schools (Government-run, Grant-in-aid, Private institutions)

Category II) Pre-university colleges, ITIs (Government-run, Grant-in-aid, Private institutions)

Category III) Polytechnic, higher education colleges, universities, and other technical institutes (Government-run, Grant-in-aid, Private institutions)

Structure and Format

- **Essay:** To be written in maximum 750 words with bilingual option of writing the essay in either Kannada or English. Prizes for both English and Kannada essays will be given separately.
- **Posters:** To be made on standard chart paper size measuring 22 X 28 inches.
- **Collage:** To be made on standard chart paper size measuring 22 X 28 inches.

Procedure for Selections of Winners

5. The winners of the district-level competitions may be decided by a committee headed by CEO, Zilla Panchayat DDPI and DDPU as members. The state-level winners will be decided by a committee headed by the Chief Electoral Officer.

Prizes

7. The winners will be awarded with the following prizes at state and district levels for each of the three institutional categories.

At district level:

- First prize – Books worth Rs 1000
- Second prize – Books worth Rs. 750
- Third prize – Books worth Rs 500

At State level:

- First prize – Books worth Rs 2000
- Second prize – Books worth Rs 1500
- Third prize – Books worth Rs 1000
