

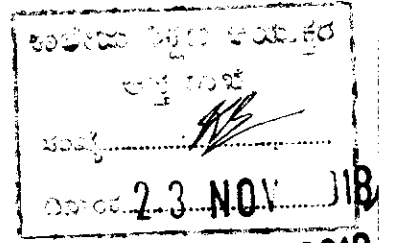

CIRCULAR

Subject: Conduct of various competitions for the students – Essay writing, Collage making, Poster making, National Quiz

In continuation of the Circulars Under ref (1) & (2) regarding conducting competition for Students of High schools, pre-university, Colleges, Poly-technic institution and Arts and Drawing schools, The following actions to be taken immediately.

1. The D.E.O / ZP C.E.O District Authorities should conduct a preliminary meeting involving all the district and SVEEP nodal officers to discuss the modalities for conducting the competitions.
2. Nodal officers, DDPIs, DDPUs, Principals and others should given suitable instruction to conduct the competition properly as per the guidelines given in the under ref (1). Copy enclosed
3. The event winners from the school / college/ university level should be forwarded to the taluk level.
4. Taluk level first prize winners will be considered at the district level competitions
5. The details of the participants should be forwarded in Annexure A & B to the concerned authorities.
6. A list of participants and winners at all levels should be uploaded in the spreadsheets given by the office of the CEO in the prescribed format given. ELC Nodal officers have to follow up for timely obtaining the information.
7. The school / college level and the taluk level competition to be completed by end of November 2018.
8. The district level competition to be completed before 10.12.2018. Nomination of the first prize name in each category to be submitted to the CEO before 14.12.2018 for the state level competitions.

9. The details of the competition to be held are as follows:



Sub:- National Voters' Day (25th January) 2019 - reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to state that the 9th National Voters' Day shall be celebrated across the country at State, District and Booth level. The theme for the 9th NVD is 'No Voter to be Left Behind' in view of the upcoming Lok Sabha Elections 2019 and should therefore aim at maximizing enrolment and building awareness in the run-up to the national elections.

2. Keeping with the theme the activities taken up in the build-up to the Lok Sabha election shall target all segments including Women, Youth, Persons with Disabilities, Senior Citizens, Service Voters, Overseas Indians besides other marginalized sections of the society.

3. Electoral Literacy Clubs shall steer the NVD celebrations in Educational Institutions. Chunav Pathshala shall act as the hub for pre-NVD activities and build-up and shall be roped in for the NVD functions at the PS level.

4. The NVD celebrations in the State, as in the past, shall have the following components in addition to any other component that the CEO and the DEO may like to incorporate:

A. KEY ACTIVITIES:

i. AT BOOTH LEVEL:

- The Booth Level Officers (BLOs) in each polling station area shall felicitate the newly registered voters on NVD in a brief ceremony/ public function.
- As prescribed by the Commission, a badge with its logo with the slogan "**Proud to be a Voter - Ready to Vote**" shall also be provided by the BLOs to the new electors during the felicitation ceremony along with their EPIC.

- c. One of the ECI films on EVM/VVPAT shall be shown at the public function, in local language. Other awareness films on Registration, Inclusion etc prepared by State or District may also be shown.
- d. The DEOs would arrange for the venue and logistics required for the brief ceremony/ public function, in each polling station area.
- e. The EROs and AEROs of the constituency shall participate in the ceremony/ public function of those Part(s) under their jurisdiction where largest number of newly registered electors would be felicitated.

ii. AT DISTRICT HQs:

- a. The DEO shall organize the NVD function at the District headquarters, in association with Panchayat organizations, academic institutions, civil society groups, organizations of youth volunteers like NSS, NCC, Scouts & Guides, NYKS, media etc.
- b. In this event, badges and EPIC shall be distributed among selected new voters as done at the Booth level function. It may be ensured that as many segments are represented among the selected new voters to be felicitated at District function.
- c. Awareness films on Registration, Inclusion etc prepared by ECI, State or District shall be shown.
- d. Outstanding performances by the ELC Schools and ELC Colleges of the district may be felicitated on the occasion.
- e. Prizes for the winners of Youth Voters' Festival may be distributed at the function.

iii. AT STATE HQs:

- a. The CEO organize the NVD function at the State capital in association with Media, Civil Society, Opinion Groups, Youth Volunteer Groups, State Administration, State Election Commission and Corporates etc.
- b. In this event also, badges and EPIC shall be distributed among selected new voters among new voters as done at the Booth level function. It may be ensured that as many segments are represented among the selected new voters to be felicitated at State function.
- c. ECI films on EVM/VVPAT, duly translated in regional language shall be screened in the State function and also shared with the district to be screened in the District and Booth Level NVD function.
- d. The State Awards shall be handed out in the function.
- e. Outstanding performances by the ELC Schools and ELC Colleges of the State may be felicitated on the occasion.
- f. Deployment of dedicated staff at Block, Sub-division and District levels may be done to effectively undertake NVD related activities. BLOs shall be trained about their role for NVD activities by the EROs/AEROs, well in advance.

B. ELECTORAL LITERACY CLUBS

ELCs were launched on the 8th NVD and have an important role to play during and around the NVD.

- i. Electoral Literacy Clubs (New Voters) in Colleges shall organize the "Youth Voters Festival" for their students and pick up any of the activities given in the Resource Book.
- ii. Similarly, ELC (Future Voters) in Schools shall celebrate NVD as given in the Resource Book
- iii. Chunav Pathshalas (Communities) shall carry out activities as a buildup to the NVD celebration in their Polling Station area by conducting activities as given in the Resource Book.

C. SERVICE VOTERS

- i. Special awareness drive may be undertaken for Service personnel utilizing the Army Day that falls on 15th January just ahead of NVD.
- ii. The Service Voter Film shared with the States may be shown in all the cinemas in the Cantonment areas and special screenings may be held to familiarise the Service personnel with the process of registration and voting.
- iii. In addition, the Service personnel may be engaged with during the NVD celebrations as well. (Pl refer to ECI's letter No 491/SVEEP-I/Service Voters/2017 dated 30/11/2017-enclosed)

D. MEDIA ENGAGEMENT

- i. CEOs and DEOs may use phone-ins on Radio and Television to engage with the electors and respond to their queries.
- ii. BLOs may participate in the phone-ins in Community Radio to respond to queries at Community level.
- iii. All forms of media i.e. print, audio-visual, outdoor advertisement, FM radio, television, SMSes, e-mails, social media, cultural troupes etc. may be utilized for awareness and propagating the theme.
- iv. Propagation of NVD theme through various Government schemes and programs.
- v. The NVD theme and related messages in form of posters and banners should be prominently displayed in the offices of the CEO, DEO, ERO and the VFCs.
- vi. A Print Advertisement shall be brought out on 25th January highlighting the theme.

E. REPUBLIC DAY TABLEAU:

In view of the Lok Sabha Election, all CEOs shall have a Tableau in RD celebration at the State level. The Tableau may be designed on the concept of 'No Voter to be Left Behind' as is being done at ECI level for the Tableau for the National Republic Day parade.

5. State Awards are to be awarded at the State NVD function.

6. The preparations for the NVD at district and booth level may be closely monitored by the office of the CEO. Two reports are to be submitted online (in the PGR portal) on the activities planned and undertaken as per the annexure, to be submitted by 1st January 2019 and 5th February 2019. Commission shall review the preparation of the NVD celebrations.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to say that the Commission has prepared voter education and awareness content for the Service personnel in the form of film, posters, radio spots and brochures on the subject of facilities being extended to them to exercise their franchise, including Electronically Transmitted Postal Ballot System (ETPBS), proxy etc. This has been shared with the CEOs besides the Service HQs and the same is also available for download at www.servicevoter.nic.in.

2. The Commission has also asked the various arms of the Armed Forces and CAPF to take up pro-active action to ensure that these contents are adequately disseminated among the service personnel and reach the personnel serving at the farthest end of the country. A copy of the letters is enclosed for your reference.

3. To facilitate the enrolment and participation of Service personnel in the electoral process, CEOs are required to support the interventions that shall be taken up by the Services, as specified in the aforesaid letters. In addition, CEOs may take up the following action:

- i. Nodal officers from the Services have been asked to be appointed. Capacity building of Nodal officers may be carried out through the office of CEO or DEO.
- ii. Special registration camp may be carried out in Cantonments in coordination with the Service Officials for registration of Service voters. Outreach and awareness may also be taken up through display of material and interactive engagement during such registration camps.
- iii. Wives of service voters may also be enrolled alongwith awareness outreach in the same or separate camps.
- iv. National Voters' Day may witness participation by Services. CEOs may invite their participation and also promote celebration of NVD in Schools run by the Services e.g. Army Public Schools etc.

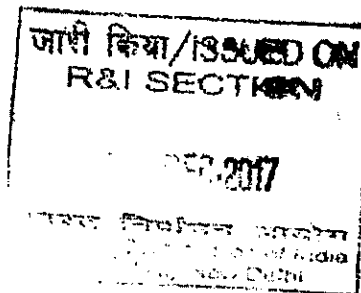
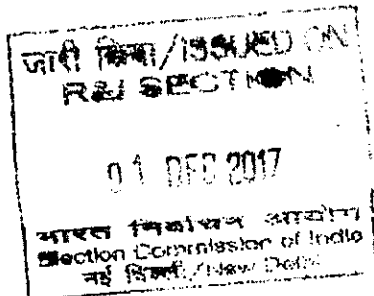
